



We're going on a toy hunt!

Choose a favourite toy or object which your child will be motivated by.

How to play.

Hide the toy/object somewhere in the room, and then tell your child they can look for the toy/object with their hands behind their back.

- They are not allowed to move anything
- You can guide them closer to the toy by giving them instructions e.g. take 2 steps forward
- Then swap over and let your child hide it and give you instructions to find it!

What your child will learn.

- How to listen and follow instructions.
- Understand language such as next to, under, below, closer.
- Develop their attention skills

What else you can do.

- Use clapping fast and slow to let your child know how close they are
- Ask your child to give you directions
- Use a smaller item to find
- Get other family members to join in and all hunt at the same time.
