Comprehension Questions

What sort of bear are we going to catch?

How do we get through the grass?

What noise does the water make?

What noise does the mud make?

Word Fun

Read out each of these lines and ask you child to complete them from memory:

We're going on a bear hunt.

What a beautiful day.

We can't go over it.

Oh no!

Talk about the meaning of these words together:

Wavy, deep, oozy, thick, swirling, whirling, narrow, gloomy,

Illustrations

Turn to the page which begins: "..... " We're not going on a bear hunt again"

Ask your child to look closely.

Now close the book and ask the questions:

Who is holding the teddy bear?

How many people are in bed?

Where is the dog?

Do you think there really was a bear?

Sequencing

Talk about the sequences of how they reached the cave. Did they cross the river and then go through the grass? Talk about when they reach the house the can the child recall they had to go back and shut the door?

Fun Activities:

Make a bear mask.

Have a teddy bears picnic.

Go for a walk in the woods.

Splash in some puddles.
